May is the month for stroke awareness, so our staff came dressed in some purple accessories. The purple shades were a huge hit!

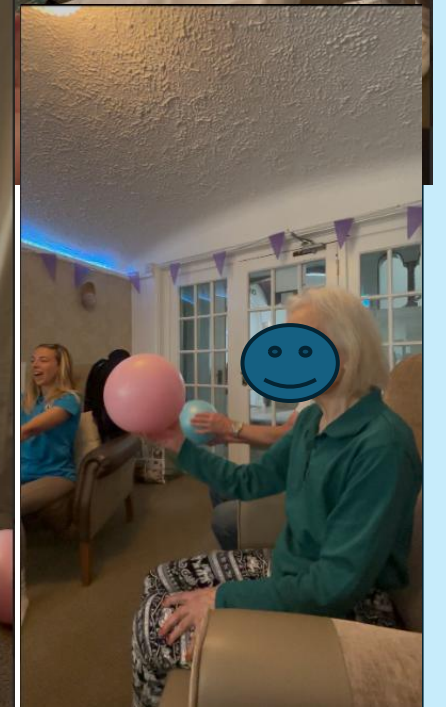
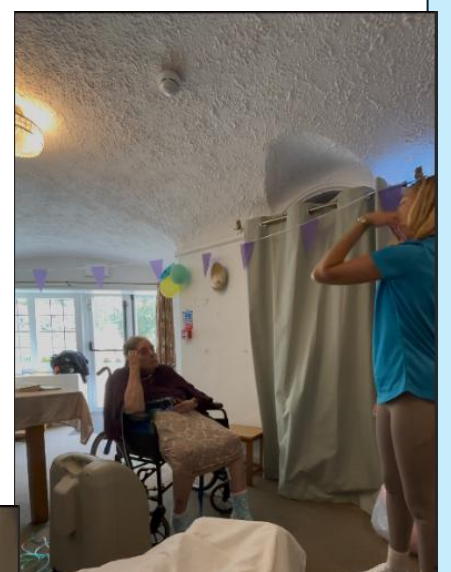


Due to the lovely sunshine we have had, John wanted to take a trip down to the Leas, which he thoroughly enjoyed.
